About Our Lakes

Fulda Area Lakes Association (FALA) supports two connecting lakes, Fulda First and Fulda Second Lake. The lakes are encompassed within both city and rural settings. Over 50% of the 3.4 miles of shoreline is located within city limits. 60+ homes are located adjacent to the lake, and 80% of these are within city limits. The 187-acre lake is supported by a 4,000-acre watershed and 94% of this watershed is tilled soil. The lakes are home to crappie, bluegill, sunfish, perch, largemouth bass, northern pike, and walleye.



Our Goals

Our Lakes Association is an organized group that came together because we care about Fulda Lakes and our surrounding community. When organized, we can work toward determining and carrying out the best actions to protect the lakes. Lake associations represent the first line of defense for protecting the water quality and ecological integrity of our lakes.

Our Function

The important function of a lake association is to serve as the organized voice for its membership with the city, township, and county governments. Having a stronger collective voice in local government and partnerships with other Minnesota Lakes Associations at the state level may help impact legislation.
